



Club Championships

Club championship events will require pre-entry. There will not normally be any walk in Bridge during club championship sessions.

All players in club championships must be financial members of the club.

Substitutes will be allowed in multi session events. The responsibility for arranging a substitute rests with the entrant. The director should be notified as soon as possible, preferably before the session, of any substitutes. Pairs with substitutes will receive normal master points, but will be ineligible for the championship title.

Teams events will permit up to 6 players per team, including substitutes

System cards are mandatory for championship events.

Movements will be chosen so that, as far as practical, each pair (or team) meets every other pair over the course of the event.

Club Trophies

Policies relating to various club trophies.

Pat Gordon Handicap Trophy

A handicapped pairs event held over 4 consecutive evenings (Usually Thursday).

The timing of the event will be determined by the TBC committee and published in the TBC calendar. The award will be made to the pair who achieve the best average score on three of the four events played, i.e. the worst score of the four rounds may be discarded. If only three rounds are played then all rounds are included in the count.

The handicap used will be that calculated by Compscore2 program.

Pat Gordon Consistency Trophy

Shall be awarded to the TBC pair who have the highest average of the twelve (12) best scores across all Monday, Tuesday and Thursday sessions from 1st January to 30th September in the current calendar year

Joan Rosenthal Handicap Trophy

Played over 4 (Monday) afternoon sessions.

The best 3 results to count.

Handicapped according to Master Point Ranking at the start of the month of the first session, on the same scale as the Pat Gordon Trophy

Awarded to the pair achieving the best handicapped average of 3 results.

Gill Bezette Novice Trophy

Recipient must be a member of Tamar Bridge Club.

Must have been playing Bridge for less than 3 years.

Must have less than 15 Master Points, as at 30th Sept.

Awarded to the eligible player earning the most Master Points in the 9 months, 1st Jan to 30th Sept.

Only Master Points earned in Tamar Bridge Club events are to count.

Master Pairs

Two divisions, Open & Restricted.

Pairs wishing to play as Restricted pairs must indicate this on their entry. Pairs with both players below the rank of National Master, as at the date of the first session of competition, are eligible to nominate as Restricted pairs.

The event will be conducted with 2 separate fields if numbers warrant it. If this is impractical, both divisions will play in a single field, with the Restricted title going to the highest ranked Restricted pair in the combined field.

Richman Blended Swiss Teams

Played over 1 or 2 days. A red masterpoint event

Entry will be made in pairs. Pairs will be seeded according to Compscore3 seeding

Teams will be formed by the top half of the pairs in order of seeding, teaming with the bottom half of pairs in reverse order of seeding.

The event will be played in a Swiss Teams format

The winners will be the top team at the end of the session(s) of play
